#### **July Highlights**

- **-Leadership Development:** Conducted two virtual training sessions for pastors in Uganda and Rwanda, focusing on servant leadership and financial stewardship.
- Child Sponsorship Drive: Launched the "100 Children for 100 days" campaign, gaining 12 new sponsors in the first month.
- **Community Empowerment:** Distributed small business grants to three women's cooperatives in rural Uganda, enabling them to start sustainable income-generating activities.
- Partnership Building: Held strategic meetings with ministry leaders in the U.S. and Africa to explore collaborative opportunities for leadership training and community development.
- Preparations for Kabale Reunion:

Finalized program outlines, speaker confirmations, and logistics for the upcoming church reunion outreach.

#### **Plans for August**

- Kabale Reunion & Outreach:

Engage in evangelism, community service, and a gospel concert aimed at strengthening local churches and communities.

- School of Ministry Development:

Begin curriculum refinement and faculty recruitment for the Empowering Nations School of Ministry.

- Child Sponsorship Campaign Expansion:

Intensify awareness efforts through social media, church visits, and community events.

- SUPA Program Implementation:

Start the first phase of the Rwanda pastoral training initiative, focusing on trauma counseling and economic empowerment.

- Fundraising & Donor Engagement:

Host an online partners' update session to share testimonies and impact stories.




#### We taught Crown's African Money Map.

The event attracted and mobilised people from

different churches within the Buganda region and as far as Kakumiro, Masaka and Buvuma islands. Mission: The objective of the World Revival Missions Media team was to provide media and digital support including broadcast and streaming services over Youtube, real time social media video reels and photography including its distribution across major social media sites.

#### **Key Outcomes**

1. Strengthened the local church team: Achieved - The Missions Media team strengthened the media team on the ground and provided leadership, bringing support from Kampala, Mbarara and the Kabale team bringing strength and expertise to the job.

Goal - to build a competent and cohesive team of media experts, developing this team over the years improving from each experience in line with the latest media trends.

We sent a team to Rwanda to study how best to work with pastors whose churches were closed. More details can be found in the report below.



#### Introduction

The government reforms introduced stringent requirements, including mandatory theological degrees for pastors, adequate parking facilities, noise regulation compliance, and other infrastructure standards that many smaller churches could not meet. While larger, established churches have remained operational, the closure of thousands of smaller congregations has created significant social, spiritual, and community challenges that continue to affect faith communities, particularly youth and children, and poorer urban and rural dwellers.

#### **Recommendations for Action**

The findings from this scoping visit reveal that while the government's intentions to professionalize Faith Institutions and protect citizens from exploitation are legitimate, the implementation of these reforms has created grave unintended consequences that require immediate and sustained intervention.

The displacement of youth and children. The increase in substance abuse, the lack of accessible counseling services, and the general deterioration of community cohesion represent serious threats to social stability and individual wellbeing that demand urgent attention. The proposal to establish provisional gathering spaces for youth and children through tents and makeshift arrangements at authorized churches offers an immediate solution to the crisis of community displacement. This approach acknowledges the urgent need for young people to maintain social connections and spiritual support while working within the constraints of current regulations.

The emphasis on facilitating theological training for affected pastors through international partnerships and online education programs represents a forwardthinking approach that could help religious leaders meet regulatory requirements while continuing to serve their communities. Moving forward, Empowering Nations (EN) 's call to be God's instrument in such a turbulent time is clear and cut out. EN is requested to consider:

- Supporting faith groups build resilience and offer a vision of hope within despair
- Equip saints with more skills
- Sustain collaboration between multiple actors. Help pastors be influencers with government agencies, faith leaders, international partners, including theological institutions and leadership academies, and community groups.

#### A Report from Afromothers Foundation

EN donated funds to enable Afromothers to get a piece of land for its operations. EN is involved with this organization because of its work with mothers and young girls. This is a way of ensuring that families are being empowered at different levels including small business loans, training, counseling and health services.

Afromothers Counsellors Talking To Girls And Boys At Seeta Secondary school In July 2025, Afromothers Uganda advanced its mission of promoting life skills in teenagers and mental wellness. At Seeta Secondary School, the team engaged 300 teenage boys and girls in an interactive Straight Talk session, holding separate discussions to create safe spaces for open dialogue.
